Announcements

1) Fellowship Meal: Every 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month we gather after our worship service to have a potluck fellowship meal together. Our next one is scheduled for August 16.

2) Guest Preacher: Reverend John Crosby is filling our pulpit again today. John is a graduate of Reformed Theological Seminary and was ordained as a minister in 2007. Since 2016, John has served with Reformed University Fellowship as campus minister to The University of Memphis.

3) Birth Choice Baby Bottle Campaign: A record amount was raised this year with 149 churches participating in West Tennessee. The total was \$184,158.92. Praise God that we were able to be a small part of this campaign and donate \$409.31. And most of all, praise God for the 62 precious babies known to have been spared from the tragedy of abortion in 10 clinic locations operated by Birth Choice.

The Proclamation of the Word: Reverend John Crosby

“God’s Everlasting Love”
Ephesians 1:1-14

Main Idea: *God’s love for you did not begin with your faithfulness, and it will not end because of your failures. In Christ, you are adopted, redeemed, and sealed forever by the God who has loved you from eternity..*

1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful in Christ Jesus: 2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Spiritual Blessings in Christ 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, 4 even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love 5 he predestined us for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, 6 to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. 7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, 8 which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight 9 making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth. 11 In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, 12 so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. 13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.
